San Diego Bay Parade of Lights Information for 2008

- The parade was presented by the Port of San Diego
- The fireworks were provided by Fireworks America & Pacific Tug & Barge
- This was the 37th annual parade on San Diego Bay
- Was held on December 14 & 21, 2008
- 85 boats were entered in the parades
- Smallest entry was a 13' self powered kayak
- Largest entry was the 138' *America* which won the runner up prize for Best Sail over 46'
